This map shows the official Church unit boundaries for your ward or stake, according to records at Church Headquarters. Please consider the following factors as you review this map:

1. All approved boundaries from previous boundary change proposals received from your ward or stake, have been incorporated in this map.
2. Do not be concerned if your map includes unshaded areas that you have not considered part of your unit. Church policy requires that all the land area of the world be included in the boundaries of an ecclesiastical Church unit. This means that rivers, lakes, national parks, golf courses, mountain ranges, and other unshaded areas may be included as part of your unit. When unit boundaries extend into unshaded areas, they are normally extended to some logical limit, such as a river, ridge line, or county boundary. When unit boundaries reflect large areas that are obviously unshaded, we can provide a zoom-in map of the parts of the unit where most of the population is shown.
